Make the sign with your right hand. Hold your arm straight up. The two raised fingers stand for two parts of the Scout Oath —"to help other people" and "to obey the Scout Law." The raised fingers look like the ears of the wolf ready to listen to Akela.





MHAT IT MEANS. HANDSHAKE. TELL SHOM THE CUB SCOUT

When you shake hands with another cub scout, do this: hold out your right hand just as you always do to shake hands. But then you put your first two fingers along the inside of the other boy's wrist. This means that you help and that you obey the Scout Law.
